Follow up

The Staff and volunteers of Indian Red Cross are doing follow up of the beneficiaries in the community after the distribution. They are instructing and guiding them to use the ITN in proper way. Moreover they used to demonstrate them to hang up the net and also asked them to keep away the net from mouse and other damage causing factors, the net should not be exposed to direct sun light.

Challenges

The Net distribution in one of the sites – Sasthankarai had to be postponed as there were some people approached from non project areas during distribution. The IRCS volunteers and staff has made the house listing based on the secondary data and defined geographical area of the community. The local leaders got involved with that confusion; they explained the people clearly and sorted out the issue.

Heavy Rains caused problem in approaching the community some times and accordingly distribution has been rescheduled, it is also assumed that it would affect our plans in coming days also.

Next Plan

After considering the community committee plans Indian Red Cross Society, Kanyakumari District Branch will be able to distribute additional 7000 nets by 30th of October. Final completion dates of distribution will be worked out.
