

# **Action recommendations:**

#### 1.Additional malaria education

- encourage all nets to be hung. Target: 95%+
- emphasise net care
- demonstrate and remind of correct net usage
- message: all sleeping spaces covered helps them all
- involve community leaders and all community
- whole community address

#### 2. Further nets required

- to achieve universal coverage/replace unusable nets
