1. Please describe the specific **locations & villages** to receive nets and the number to each? Please provide longitude/latitude information. (Important note: If the distribution is approved, approval will be for the nets to be distribution to these specific locations. Location changes will only be considered, and may be refused, if due to exceptional/unforeseen circumstances.)

This distribution will be on Bujako Island, Mpigi District. The distribution will cover 5 villages: Buzami, Munyonyo, Bugoma, Kinyinambo & Lumbebe.

Latitude. -0.05°, Longitude. 32.1166667°

2. Is this an **urban or rural area** and how many people live in this specific area?

Approx 400,000 people live on the island, exact numbers for the 5 villages are not known.

3. Is this a **high risk malaria area**? If yes, why do you designate it as high?

This is a high risk area not just because of Uganda being a high risk country but because of the location & the conditions these children live in. The homes are in very poor condition. There is no drainage & very poor sanitation. The area is prone to substantial flooding & malaria fatalities are high. Although the land is fertile, geographically this area is known to be prone to mosquitoes.

4. Baseline malaria case information. How many **reported cases of malaria** and **malaria deaths** were there in this **specific** area in the most recent period available? We are looking for data from health clinics in the area. Month by month information is strongly preferred. We are NOT looking for regional level/national level information. Please cite your source. Baseline malaria case information forms the basis of comparison post-distribution.

According to the Buzami Clinic which is the clinic that serves these 5 villages, they report approx 15 children & 8 adults a week with malaria. They 'believe' that the average number of deaths to be approx 1-2 per week. However this data is not confirmed as many of the people who die do not die in the clinic but in their homes.

5. Is this distribution of nets 'blanket coverage' of an area/village or to a select/vulnerable group? If the latter, please describe this group.

This area has been identified as an area in need of mosquito nets. As a childrens charity we have enlisted local help to list the number of children residing in the 5 villages. Nets will be distributed to all children under 16 years. This area was recommended for support by the Uganda Ministry of Health.

6. What is the existing level of ITN use in this area? Are there existing bednet distribution programmes in this area?

According to information received from the clinic, some years back (date not known but over 4 years ago), approx 50 nets were given to pregnant women. It is believed that they were distributed by Concern, but the people involved in this have now left the clinic.

7. Why was the area/villages chosen for bednet distribution and who made this decision? Please provide the name, position and organisation of the person/s making the decision.

The decision was made by myself Nikki Collinson in line with our mission statement of providing nets to children involved in Uganda. The decision was supported by the Uganda Ministry of Health.

8. Have you consulted with the country's National Malaria Programme about this distribution and what was their response? Please provide the name, position and contact details of the person/s with whom you have liaised.

I have been in contact with them in the past regarding our distributions & will be advising them of this distribution once it has been approved. They are fully aware of this distribution.

We have had officials in the 5 villages working with village leaders to ascertain the required numbers.

12. Please describe how the bednets will be distributed and by whom. Please give detail. Please indicate over what time period (typically, the number of days or weeks) the distribution will occur.

We (the ACDT) will be distributing the nets ourselves voluntarily to the children. This will take place on one day in March 2010.

13. Please describe the malaria education component of the distribution. Please give a detailed answer.

As part of this distribution, talks will be given on the benefits of using nets, the correct way to hang the nets, caring for your nets. We will be on hand to assist in the hanging of the nets & for any questions relating to malaria prevention.

We will be visiting the site 3 weeks following the distribution & we will provide you with the data.
