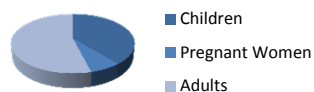

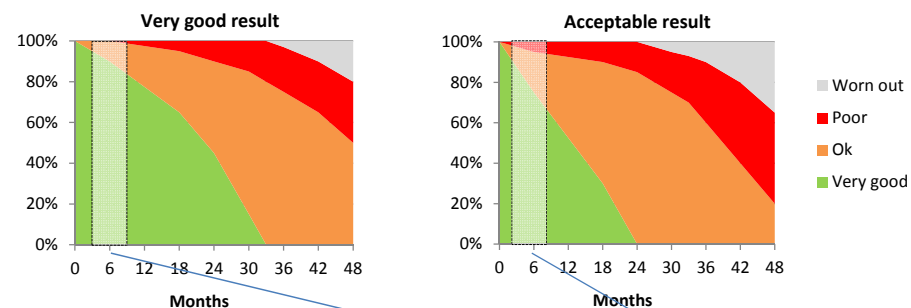


What is the overall coverage of sleeping spaces?

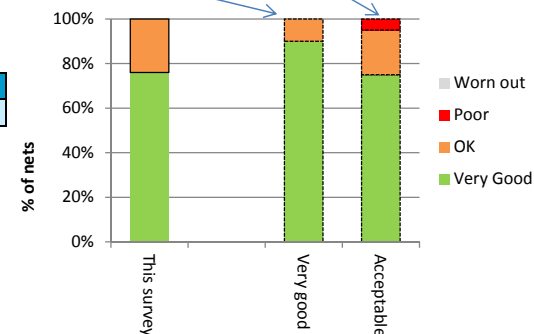
What are our expectations for the condition of the nets over time?
