The registration statement, fifty dollar (\$50) registration fee, and supporting documents to register World Swim for Malaria Foundation (The) as a charitable organization have been received and filed in my office, and are now a matter of public record.

Please keep in mind that a renewal registration will need to be received on or before February 09, 2007, and that all documents required to complete the charitable registration should be received by the expiration date. If all documents are not received, we will send you a reminder and may allow a brief extension period as a matter of courtesy. However, if you are aware that you will require additional time, you must request an extension, which is a one time only, nonrenewable, 90-day extension. Without this request, the West Virginia law requires a twenty-five dollar (\$25) late filing fee for each month or part of a month thereof.

In addition, the acceptance of your application for registration does not imply endorsement or waive the authority of this office to monitor the operation of your charitable organization, your solicitation materials, or your professional fund-raising counsel or solicitor.
